## How to Reach Durga Soren University, Deoghar, Jharkhand

Deoghar is a city and a municipal corporation in Deoghar district of Jharkhand. It is also the administrative headquarters of Deoghar district. Deoghar is a holy place. The city is primarily known for Baidyanath Temple, one of the 12 Jyotirlingas of Shiva, one of the principal deities in Hinduism. The sacred temples of the city make this a place for pilgrimage and tourists. Deoghar Airport served the Deoghar city, which is approximately 12 km from the city centre. As of now IndiGo operates its flight services only for Ranchi, Patna, Bengaluru, Mumbai, Kolkata and Delhi. Jasidih Junction is the nearest train station serving Deoghar. It is located on the Howrah–New Delhi main line train route by which it is connected from all over the country. Deoghar Junction is the railway station located in the city. It is on the Jasidih-Dumka-Rampurhat & Jasidih-Banka-Bhagalpur line. There are trains to Ranchi, Dumka, Rampurhat, Munger, Bhagalpur, Banka, Agartala etc. Baidyanathdham Deoghar railway station is a terminal station located in the city centre connected directly by Jasidih junction. It mostly serves passengers trains but some express trains are also connected including a Vande Bharat to Varanasi.

## Accommodation
